Terms & Conditions

In the following Terms and Conditions:

- "Business" shall mean CT Timelapse
- "Client(s)" shall mean "You" the parties to the contract
- "Services" shall mean any time-lapse photography or accompanying video services carried out at the event or on site and any other services agreed between the Client(s) and CT Timelapse set out in the contract.

Delivery

- 1. Final Time-lapse videos are owned by the client once payment is made in full. CTTimelapse retains the rights to all raw and original content.
- 2. CTTimelapse can share and distribute all finalised videos for marketing purposes.
- 3. All final time-lapse videos will be delivered online unless requested otherwise.

Prices/ Payment

1. A 25% deposit is required up front before any work commences. Further invoices to be submitted on a weekly basis and to be paid within 30 days unless instructed otherwise by CTTimelapse.

Liability

- 1. If a time-lapse project fails due to CTTimelapse technical difficulties the client will receive a full refund for the affected period of time.
- 2. Due to the nature of external time-lapse work CTTimelapse is not responsible for adverse weather conditions/ forces of nature/ acts of terrorism or God that effects the final video.
- 3. The client is liable for all security measures and must ensure all efforts are made to keep the cameras secure on site.

Termination

- 1. A full refund shall be given if the Client wishes to terminate the project with 1 weeks notice. Any less than one weeks notice and a refund isn't available.
- 2. If CTTimelapse has to cancel the installation, due to circumstances beyond their control, the full amount of the deposit and any further payments shall be returned to the client.
- 3. Where it is possible, a reshoot may be arranged. However CTTimelapse is not responsible or liable for any additional costs incurred by the client.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

The parties irrevocably agree any dispute arising out of this contract shall be governed and construed in accordance with English Law and that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim.
